

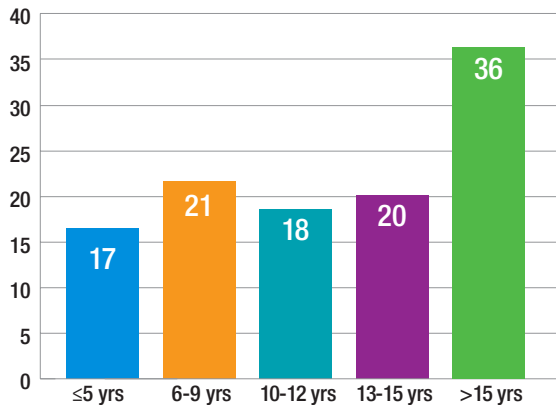

Half (50 percent) of the admissions were teenagers, age 13 years and older.

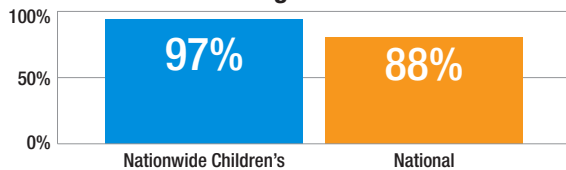
Age Groups

Discharge to Home



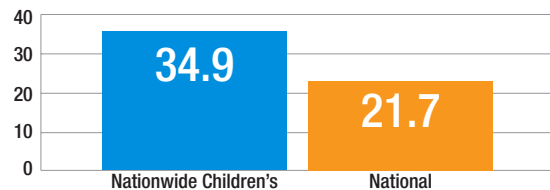
Customer Satisfaction
