Type 2 Diabetes Correlated with Decreased Stiffness of Coronary Microvessels, Implicated in Diabetic Heart Disease

Aaron J. Trask, PhD, principal investigator in the Center for Cardiovascular and Pulmonary Research at The Research Institute at Nationwide Children's Hospital, is senior author of an *Annals in Biomedical Engineering* study that demonstrates differences in the stiffness of particular blood vessels in the presence of Type 2 diabetes, a primarily adult-onset condition that has increased in the obese pediatric population over the last two decades.


