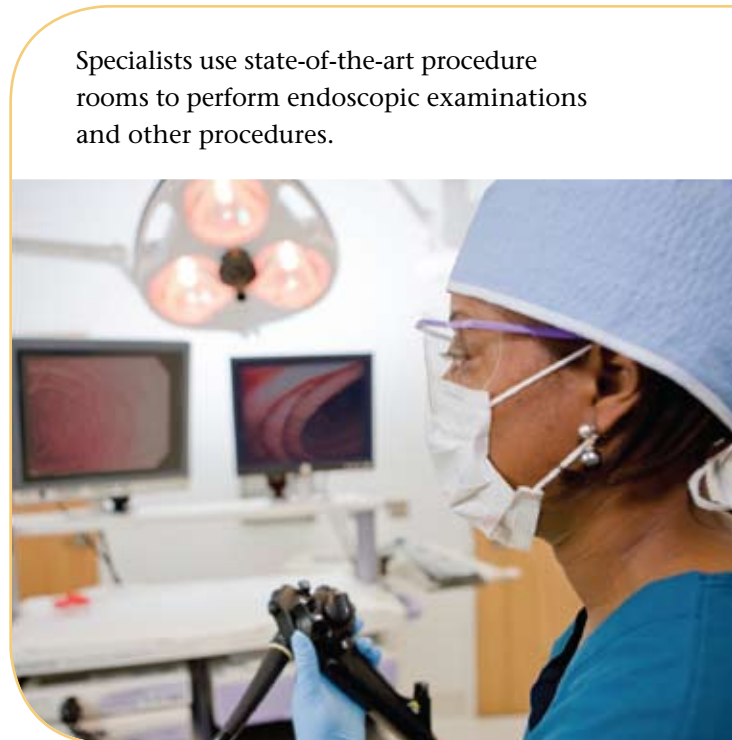


:: Comprehensive Gastroenterology Care
