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<b>Auxiliary labeling/Storage: Refrigerate Only; Shake Well</b> No room temperature stability information.
<b>Directions:</b> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Place tablets into amber plastic prescription bottle.</li><li>2. Add distilled water.</li><li>3. Cap and shake mixture for 2 minutes.</li><li>4. Let stand for 1 hour, and then shake for 1 more minute.</li><li>5. Add vehicle to bottle and shake for 1 minute.</li></ol>
