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**Equipment needed:**  
Mortar, pestle, graduated cylinder, stirring rod

**Auxiliary Labels/Storage: Shake Well; Refrigerate**  
No room temperature stability information.

**Directions:**

1. Crush tablets in a mortar and triturate to a fine powder.
2. Wet powder with glycerin and levigate to form a viscous, but smooth and uniform paste.
3. Add cherry syrup, geometrically, mixing well after each addition.
4. Transfer to a graduate.
5. Rinse mortar with simple syrup, adding rinse to graduate, until almost final volume.
6. QS to final volume with simple syrup. Stir well.

**Final Product Description:** Dark red, opaque suspension. Small coating particles may not dissolve completely and may be visible in suspension.
