Pyrazinamide	Oral	Suspension	100mg/mL

Formula Qty: 100mL	Shelf Life: 60 days
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Equipment needed: Mortar, pestle, graduated cylinder, stirring rod
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Auxiliary Labels/Storage: Shake Well; Refrigerate Room temperature stability=45 days
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Directions: <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Crush tablets in a mortar and triturate to a fine powder.2. Wet powder with a minimal amount of vehicle and levigate to form a viscous, but smooth and uniform paste.3. Continue adding vehicle, geometrically, mixing well after each addition.4. Transfer to a graduate.5. Rinse mortar with vehicle, adding rinse to graduate.6. QS to final volume with vehicle. Stir well.
