



Fundraising Ideas for Schools

• Preschool to Elementary

- My Place Child Care Center in Newark helped teach students to distinguish coins and learn their value by keeping them in separate containers; used the money in counting exercises; and tallied their Penny War totals at \$121.83.
- Meet county-standards by teaching students the important of community and philanthropy

• Elementary to Middle School

- Incorporate math or banking lessons
- Run a small business (i.e. bake sale, book sale) and teach supply and demand, customer service, staff scheduling, advertising tactics, etc.
- Glacier Ridge Elementary of Dublin took the challenge home and students collected money by doing extra chores; they raised more than \$1,500.

• Middle School to High School

- ScholArts Public Community School in downtown Columbus gave its students the opportunity to pay \$1 to break out of their uniforms and dress in jeans every Friday; they raised \$500 in just one semester.

- Sell candy, flowers or balloons on holiday
- Participate in “theme” week or dress-down days (i.e. pajama day, jean’s day, etc.)
