



Bathroom

- Medicine cabinet cleaned out. Unused or outdated medicines are thrown away. **
- No drain or bowl cleaners under the sink.
- Bleach/detergent is not left out in measuring cup or glass.
- Cosmetics, colognes, mouth wash, hair products, relaxers, and medicines are out of sight & out of reach.

Bedroom

- No medicines on nightstand and drawers
- Perfumes, cosmetics, powders, make-up and other personal care items are stored out of sight and out of reach.

Kitchen

- No household cleaners are under the sink: dishwashing and dishwasher soap, ammonia, oven cleaner, drain or toilet bowl cleaners, bleach, furniture polish, window cleaner, bug spray etc.
- Poisonous products are NOT stored next to food items.
- Bleach/detergent is not left out in measuring cup or glass.
- No medicines on counters or window sills.

General Household

- Alcoholic beverages and cigarettes are out of reach, ashtrays are empty and clean.
- Purses (including visitors' and babysitters') are out of reach.
- No rat or ant poisons where children play.
- Lamp oil is in its original container ONLY and stored out of reach.
- Coins, small batteries and magnets are out of reach.

Outside

- Know what kind of berries, fruits, seeds, flowers, shrubs, and trees are in your yard.
- Teach children NOT to eat any mushrooms or toadstools found in the yard.
- Do not let children play on pesticide-treated lawn for 24 hours.

Basement/Laundry room/Garage/Shed

Store out of sight & out of reach from children:

- Detergent, bleach, spot cleaner, fabric softener. Make sure bleach or detergents are not left out in measuring cups or a glass.

Keep locked in places where children do not have access:

- Bug spray, weed killer, fertilizer
- Gasoline, kerosene, turpentine, charcoal, paints

** Safely dispose expired or unused medication by putting them in a small plastic bag, add a little water and some cat litter or coffee grounds, seal and throw it in the trash. Make sure there are no personal information left on the prescription bottle. Please recycle the bottles if possible.
