

## **December 2010 - Updates for Nursing Instructors at Nationwide Children's Hospital**

Happy Holidays to all!

1. New parking areas were assigned in November 2010 for nursing instructors and students. The new parking lot is at 494 East Rich Street with overflow parking at 430 East Mound Street. See the attached map. A shuttle regularly passes these lots from 6:00 AM to 7:00 PM, with service available up to midnight. When you arrive in the lot, stay in your locked car until you see the shuttle. The shuttle will pick up and drop off at the Out Patient Care Clinic (OCC). Nursing instructors and students are encouraged to call Security at 722-2128 for shuttle service immediately when you arrive in the lot and for transportation from the OCC outside of the established hours.
2. New observations for the undergraduate nursing students beginning in January 2011 include: the Cardiac Catheterization Lab, Plastic Surgery Clinic and the Urgent Care (Main Campus). See the Observation Book. Please share any new ideas for observations with the Department of Professional Development to research the feasibility of the experiences.
3. Please notify the Department of Professional Development immediately if the location of any observation site has changed.
4. All observations for undergraduate nursing students are listed in the Observation Book. Do not independently contact units or clinics to request additional experiences.
5. All observations must be requested at least two weeks in advance.
6. A nursing instructor from the school that requested the observation, must be at the facility location of the observation experience during the entire observation, i.e., during an observation of the Transport, the nursing instructor must remain at the Main Hospital at Nationwide Children's Hospital during the entire observation.
7. Nationwide Children's Hospital now operates the Level III Newborn Intensive Care (NICU) at St. Ann's campus in Westerville. Please do not independently request undergraduate nurse preceptor placements in NICU from St. Ann's. Additionally, Ohio Health's NICU undergraduate nurse preceptor placements are assigned by the Department of Professional Development. Please do not independently request undergraduate nurse preceptor placements from any units.
8. The Clinical Coordinator for the undergraduate precepted nursing student is responsible for providing information to the Information Security Department in preparation for Epic electronic medical record fingerprinting. The Clinical Coordinator is responsible for accompanying the student to the IS Depot for fingerprinting.
9. Encourage all of the nursing students to complete Evaluations of their experiences on line (See the Schools of Nursing website for access). Encourage them to list the units of their experiences and specific names of staff (first and last name), as appropriate. These details assist us in the follow up.
