1. The 2008 satisfaction rate of our customers, including patients, families, payer sources and referring physicians, was 99%.
2. We are accredited by the Joint Commission on Accreditation of Healthcare Organizations (JCAHO) and the Commission on Accreditation of Rehabilitation Facilities (CARF) for our pediatric family-centered rehabilitation program.
3. We are a pediatric family-centered inpatient rehabilitation program. The child/adolescent and family are the core of our Rehabilitation Team. Parents are considered an extension of their child, not a visitor.
4. Our most important goal of rehabilitation is to successfully return patients to home, school, and community. Our successful school reintegration program involves the family and school as key players.
5. We are located within a 418-bed pediatric Level I Trauma Hospital, with direct and immediate medical services available.
6. We feel that adolescents are not little adults but are individuals that are still developing and maturing, who need the "family-centered" approach to rehabilitation.
7. All of our patient rooms are private with an attached bathroom and tub/shower.
8. Parents are welcome to spend the night in their child's room. We also have a Ronald McDonald facility located on our campus.
