# **Program Conditions/Bid Criteria/General Notes**

#### 1.0 Introduction

It is the responsibility of the Architect and Sign Contractor(s) to become thoroughly familiar with the nature of the signage work to be performed. Site walk-throughs may be coordinated with the Nationwide Children's Hospital (NCH) NCH Interiors Team.

Note: Sign Contractor shall also refer to the Terms and Conditions as provided by the Nationwide Children's Hospital NCH Interiors Team on a per-project basis.

## 2.0 Design Intent Documentation

Do not scale these design drawings as they provide general guidance only. The Sign Contractor must produce final engineering/fabrication drawings which conform to the overall design drawing as presented. After studying the drawings and support materials, the Sign Contractor may provide specific recommendations and/or modifications which will contribute to the enhanced quality and distinctive appearance of the program. Refer to the final message schedule for approved copy on all signs.

#### 3.0 Scheduling

NCH Interiors Team will establish any scheduling priorities for installation of signs.

#### 4.0 Field Verification

The Sign Contractor shall have total responsibility to field verify all dimensional information prior to producing engineering/fabrication drawings.

# **5.0 Site Signage Location Maps** and Color Proofs

It is the responsibility of the Sign Contractor or Architect to provide NCH Interiors Teams the following:

- A. Site sign location map(s)of each sign and any power requirements noted by a symbol for existing and a symbol for new power.
- B. A message schedule of each sign content on projects having multiple versions of each sign type.
- C. Color proofs of all sign art generated prior to fabrication. These can be in print or PDF form. No project can proceed to fabrication without sign-offs from the NCH Interiors Team.

The NCH Interiors Team will provide direction on building names and possible sign content and coordinate with the Sign Contractor on nomenclature and wayfinding philosophy.

#### **6.0 Quality Assurance**

The Sign Contractor is responsible for the quality and delivery of all materials, workmanship and installation work required for the successful completion of the contract.

The Sign Contractor shall warrant all signage free of defects in material or workmanship and shall provide NCH with a warranty as per the Terms and Conditions of contract of supplementary conditions.

The Sign Contractor will be responsible for providing approved subcontractors with complete up-to-date drawings and all project support information.

The Sign Contractor/Architect shall notify NCH Interiors Team of any discrepancies in these design drawings, as well as in-field dimensions or conditions. Issues regarding message fit (line length) or accurate reproduction of the NCH logo must be brought to the attention of the NCH Interiors Team prior to execution.

UL required identification labels must be placed on a non-conspicuous sign surface for internally illuminated signs. The Sign Contractor shall provide the Owner with complete lamp and power supply replacement information, brand, type, wattage, color, etc. for LEDs for in-field servicing.

#### **7.0 Permits/Code Compliance**

Prior to production, the Sign Contractor shall secure all required permits, inspections, and tests for the construction and placement of signage as required by applicable governing authorities. Stamped engineering drawings must meet all structural requirements as dictated by the sign building codes for this region.

# 8.0 Materials and Lighting

All materials utilized in the construction of signage must take into consideration environmental conditions typical of this region. Sign panels must maintain surfaces free from oil canning, warping, distortion or any irregularities or inconsistencies. Fasteners must be concealed wherever practical and unless specified in this document, and must be fabricated from metals that are non-corrosive to either the sign materials or the mounting surface.

Sign materials selected for printing processes and materials for reproduction of digital images must include manufacturer's performance criteria for approval, along with finished samples, prior to fabrication. All alternative sign material recommendations by the sign company will need to be evaluated.

All internal and external lighting should be 6500 K color balanced LEDs, with appropriate power supplies and transformers. Power supplies should be contained within UL certified junction boxes or within sign cabinets for easy access.

The Sign Contractor is responsible for even illumination without hot spotsor dark areas.

# 9.0 Samples/Submissions

The Sign Contractor may be required to produce actual sign prototypes and color spray-outs if requested by Owner to insure conformity to the overall design intent as presented. These samples must be approved by the NCH Interiors Team prior to fabrication.

#### 10.0 Finishes and Corners

All sharp corners and edges must be softened on ground level signs to prevent injuries to patients, visitors and staff.

Matthews® Paint are the preferred paint system for NCH. All exposed finishes are to be matte.

3M,® Avery® and Oracal® Vinyl is specified for all opaque, translucent and reflective graphic film applications.

# 11.0 Security/Safety

The Sign Contractor shall adhere to a safety program and at all times enforce all safety codes and

standards required by OSHA and the State of Ohio, or any other applicable state or federal agency.

The Sign Contractor is responsible for the erection and dismantling of all barricades necessary to safeguard the public during installation, and for total protection of the work and materials installed. Installation plans and schedules shall be approved by NCH Interiors Team.

# **12.0 Site Preparation, Installation and Completion**

The Sign Contractor shall contact all utilities and third party utility locators to mark all possible underground utilities prior to installing new foundations. Hydrovac excavation is an option based upon site location and potential underground utility issues.

Location of irrigation system to be coordinated with NCH Interiors Team.

All required sign foundations are to meet local/county codes and engineered by the Sign Contractor. All excavation and site work shall be returned to its original grade configuration after the sign components have been installed.

All debris and packing materials shall be removed and properly disposed of. Upon completion of the installation, all soiled sign surfaces must be cleaned in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions and touched up as required.

# 13.0 Digital Control Drawing and Artwork Files

The official NCH signage logos, symbols and custom design graphic components will be furnished to the selected Sign Contractor as the original native vector (Illustrator) files.




# **Minimum Distances Indicated**



**Example Horizontal Layout with Co-Brand Partner** 




**Example Door Vinyl**
