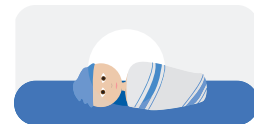

### **Nationwide Children's Hospital Main Campus**

- Level IV NICU including acute care, BPD care and transitional care
- Total bed capacity of 130
- Fetal Center, ECMO, surgical and sub-specialty services
- Neonatal follow up and outreach programs

### **Nationwide Children's Hospital - Toledo**

- 30 bed Level III NICU located in downtown Toledo

### **Riverside Methodist Hospital**

- 48 bed Level III NICU located in perinatal regional referral hospital with high volume and high risk deliveries

### **Dublin Methodist Hospital**

- 7 bed Level II NSCU located in a community hospital with a robust delivery service
- Conceptual family centered care atmosphere

### **Doctors Hospital**

- 8 bed Level III NICU in central Ohio's osteopathic hospital with delivery services

### **Grant Medical Center**

- 17 bed Level III NICU in the heart of Columbus with delivery services

- 21 bed Level III NICU in the city's northeast side with delivery services

### **The Ohio State University Wexner Medical Center**

- 38 bed Level III NICU located in a perinatal regional referral center

## **Neonatal Advanced Practice Provider Program**

Neonatal APPs are an important part of the interdisciplinary care team. They have a great degree of autonomy within their collaborative relationships with the neonatologists, pediatric surgeons and other subspecialty team members with whom they work.

- Neonatal APPs support 310 neonatal beds across 10 individual NICUs and NSCUs located in 7 different hospitals in Columbus, Ohio, offering various environments for professional and personal growth
- The Neonatal Network's areas of excellence includes NEC, BPD, ELBW care and Fetal Care
- Nationwide Children's Neonatal APP Program offers a nationally accredited Neonatal APRN Transition to Practice Fellowship for new-to-practice APRNs as well as a Neonatal PA Fellowship program
- Professional development model utilizes novice to expert format
