About SEARCH

Founded in 2007 by The Heart Center at Nationwide Children’s Hospital, S.E.A.R.C.H. (Summer Education and Research in Clinical Healthcare Internship) is for undergraduate students interested in a career in scientific research, medicine and allied health. Based on your application and areas of interest, you will be placed in one of three programs -- Cardiology Care, Primary Care or Research. Following the program, you will be required to give a formal presentation regarding your experience.

The program offers:

- **Stipend** – Six week stipend. Applicable taxes will apply.
- **Community Support** – Establish connections within the healthcare profession and Columbus community.
- **Mentorship & Career Guidance** – Each scholar is assigned a SEARCH Advisor. Through individual counseling and personal development workshops, scholars will be able to better prepare themselves to successfully reach their goals.
- **Shadowing Opportunities** – Scholars will build cultural competency and increase career awareness by having a variety of shadowing opportunities. Scholars will make more realistic self-evaluations of their own motivation and intentions surrounding their career choice.
- **Professional Development** – Along with your six week experience, you will have the opportunity for ongoing learning via assessments, panel discussions, one-on-one meetings, etc. Support and resources are available to achieve post-secondary academic success leading to professional careers in the healthcare field.
- **Housing & Transportation** – Nationwide Children’s will provide campus housing for scholars as needed. Campus housing is within walking distance to and from the hospital. Additionally, Nationwide Children’s will pay reasonable round-trip travel costs to the program. Interns will receive a monthly food stipend.



Qualifications *(applicants must meet all criteria)*

- Currently attending an accredited U.S. university
- Entering junior or senior year of college in the fall of 2020.
- Minimum GPA of 3.5.
- Must demonstrate interest in medical or graduate school.
- Pass a background check, drug screen and all standard Nationwide Children’s related requirements for employees.
- Must be fully vaccinated

Attendance and Commitment

The SEARCH Program is a full-time commitment. S.E.A.R.C.H. participants spend a **minimum** of 40 hours a week in their internship activities. Most of the internship occurs during the day but there are some mandatory evening programs and mixers.

Application and Deadline

A competitive program; the application process will consist of two rounds of interviews. Candidates are selected based on the merits of their application and their interview techniques.
