Instructions to access CME On Demand Courses using the External Portal

1. **Clinical User site:**

2. **Self-Register for access:**
 - Enter your First and Last Name
 - Enter your Email Address
3. **Select a Division:** Either Physician or Non-Physician
4. **Select your Position:** Select your position from the list or select other.
5. **Create and confirm your password.**
6. **Click in the "I'm not a robot" box to complete your registration.**
7. Once you've created your username and password, you can scroll down and **Select "Login In"**





15. Click the “**Evaluate**” and “**Continue**” button to start the evaluation.




