Instructions to access CME On Demand Courses using the External Portal

* Required Field

1. Clinical User site: https://bit.ly/CMEOnDemand

2. Self-Register for access:

- Enter your First and Last Name
- o Enter your Email Address
- 3. Select a Division: Either Physician or Non-Physician
- Select your Position: Select your position from the list or select other.
- 5. Create and confirm your password.
- 6. Click in the "I'm not a robot" box to complete your registration.
- Once you've created your username and password, you can scroll down and Select "Login In"

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8.	Enter your email address as your Username, enter the password you
	created and click Enter.

9. This will open the **Home** page, search for your course by year, title or speaker, i.e. **2020 Pediatric Grand Rounds 1-9-20.**

Unsure? Just search Pediatric Grand Rounds and scroll through the list.

10. From the search results, click on the course link.

12. The curriculum will open. Next to the Video icon, click the blue "Activate", then "Launch" to view the module. Each part needs completed to consider the course "COMPLETE".



13. Once the video presentation has been viewed, click the blue "Mark Complete" button.





14. Once you click "Mark Complete", the test will become available. Click "Activate" then, "Launch Test". Notice the "Curriculum Progress" will also update.



- This starts the Exam, click "Continue" to start the test
- Select the correct answer(s) for each question, click the "Summary" button when done.
- When all questions are answered, click "Submit Final Answers" button.
- After reviewing your score, click "Done".

Notice the "Curriculum Progress" page is updated.

15. Click the "Evaluate" and "Continue" button to start the evaluation.



- Answer each question, click "Next" to continue to the next page.
- Click "Submit Final Answers" to complete the evaluation.
- This will return you to the updated Curriculum Progress screen.
