

Department of Pediatrics Master's Program Funding

The Department of Pediatrics is pleased to offer competitive funding for up to 10 fellows interested in obtaining a Master's degree, such as Master of Public Health (MPH), Master of Medical Science (MMS), Master of Science (MS) and Master in Biomedical Education (MA). Funding is contingent upon timely enrollment in a Master's degree program. The student must maintain a 3.0 GPA or higher and continually progress towards attaining the degree. All funding must be approved by the Master's Program Funding Committee.

The programs in MPH and MMS at OSU accept applications throughout the year however, applications must be submitted to the NCH Funding committee by the deadlines specified below. Students must submit a list of classes they are enrolled in at least one month prior to the start of each term.

Interested candidates must:

- 1. Complete the application forms and process in the Advanced Degree Program (OSU or elsewhere)
- 2. Complete the Department of Pediatrics Advanced Degree Tuition Funding application.

Fellows are able to apply for in-state tuition after maintaining Ohio residency for 12 months. After this 12-month period, the fellow is responsible for working towards applying for Ohio residency and in-state tuition. Otherwise, the fellow will become financially responsible for all out-of-state tuition expenses.

Applications will only be accepted once per year.Application Period begins December 1 and ends January 6
