MR Brain No Contrast	↔	MR Head Without Contrast
MR Foreign Reference	↔	MR Foreign Reference
US Abdomen	↔	US Abdomen
US Infant Hips w/o Physician Manipulation	↔	US Infant Hip Without Dynamic Manipulation
US Renal	↔	US Kidney

- For MR procedures without contrast – examples of when ***you would*** order contrast include (1) for follow up tumors and (2) infection
- MR Foreign Reference – MR of Knee or Hip (order for infection, tumor or arthritis)
- US Renal to Kidney - Appendix or Pylorus

XR Lumbar AP/Lat	↔	XR Lumbar - AP and Lateral
XR Pelvis AP w/ Frog Lat	↔	XR Pelvis AP with Frog Lateral
XR Scoliosis PA	↔	XR Scoliosis - PA Only
XR Scoliosis PA/Lat	↔	XR Scoliosis - PA and Lateral
XR Tib/Fib Left	↔	XR Tibia and Fibula - Left
XR Tib/Fib Right	↔	XR Tibia and Fibula - Right

- XR
 - Chest radiographs are now XR Chest
 - Acute abdominal series are XR Abdomen (with views)
 - XR Foot 2 View Left is now XR Foot – Left
 - Frog view versus Hip (which includes individual hips vs complete pelvis)
 - Supine Abdomen versus Upright Abdomen – Supine is a reasonable screen but the upright might be more appropriate for bowel abnormalities
