



Reasons for Taking This Medicine:

- To give you fast relief from asthma symptoms of coughing, wheezing, or shortness of breath.
- This medicine works by opening the airways. It usually works within 15 minutes.
- If you are in the **yellow**, **orange or red** zone of your asthma action plan, use this medicine.
- Your doctor may also tell you to use this medicine 15-30 minutes before exercising.

When and How to Use This Medicine:

- Use the prescribed number of puffs for coughing, wheezing, or shortness of breath.
- Use a spacer and mask with this inhaler.

The first time you use a new albuterol inhaler:

- Shake it and then push down on the top of the inhaler.
- Spray the medicine into the air 4 times.
- After you do this, the dose counter will be at 200.
- Now it is ready to use (primed).

Use These Steps to Take the Medicine

1 Place the <u>inhaler</u> in the end of spacer.

2 Shake well for 10 seconds.

3 Place mask tightly over the nose and mouth.

• Push down on the inhaler




A Breathe in and out 6-8 times.


• If the spacer has a nose valve (flap), you will see it move with each breath.


6 Wait 1 minute.


6 Repeat steps 2-4 for your next puffs.

















Wait at least 4 hours between doses.

Possible Side Effects:

- Fast heart beat
- Can make you feel hyper or shaky
- Can make you fussy or irritable
- Sore throat
- Headache


Call the Doctor or Clinic If:

- This medicine doesn't help your coughing, wheezing, or shortness of breath.
- You need to use your inhaler again in less than 4 hours.
- You often need to use your inhaler many times a week for relief of symptoms.
- You have questions about your medicine.

Go to an Urgent Care, ER or Call 911:

• After using this medicine and it is still hard to breathe or you are wheezing badly.





Important Things to Remember:

- If you haven't used this inhaler in 2 weeks, prime with 1 puff before using.
- Never remove the metal canister from the inhaler or put the inhaler in water.
- One time each week, clean the inhaler by wiping a cotton swab in the opening where the medicine sprays out.
- One time each week, clean spacer and mask by:
 - Soaking in warm soapy water for 15 minutes.
 - Running warm water through it.
 - Shaking off water and setting it out to dry.
- This inhaler does have a dose counter. Refill your inhaler when the dose counter reads 20. (The inhaler will run out of medicine at "0" even if it still sprays.)

How to Store:

- In a cool, dry cabinet
- Don't store it in the bathroom.
- Keep it out of reach of young children even when the inhaler is for your child.
