
Reason for taking this medicine:

- To decrease the amount of mucus in the airways.
- This is a controller medicine and will not help if you are coughing, wheezing, or have shortness of breath.
- This is a medicine that must be used every day.
- This medicine may also be used to treat and control allergy symptoms.

How and when to take medicine:







Granules:

- Use 1 packet of granules 1 time a day in the evening.
- Granules can be poured directly into mouth.
- Granules can be added to a small amount (5mL) of formula or breast milk.
- Granules can be mixed with soft food such as:



Applesauce

Ice cream

Rice





- Use the mixture within 15 minutes.
- Food should be cold or room temperature.

Possible side effects:

- Upset stomach
- Fever
- Stuffy nose
- Cough
- Headache






Call the doctor or clinic if:

- You have changes in your behavior or mood.
- You have flu-like symptoms.
- You have a rash.
- You have questions about this medicine or how to use it.

Important things to remember:

- If you suddenly have trouble breathing, <u>use your rescue inhaler</u>, <u>albuterol</u>.
- Singulair may take up to a week before it starts to work.
 Use this medicine until your doctor tells you to stop.
- Do not use chewable tablets if you are allergic to phenylalanine or you have been diagnosed with PKU.

How to store:





Keep out of reach of children.
