

Annual TB Testing for Adult/College Volunteers

As a Volunteer in a health care setting, the Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) requires testing for the prevention and transmission of Mycobacterium tuberculosis. Nationwide Children's Hospital volunteers are now required to have an annual TB test. This is a CDC requirement based on the hospital's risk due to the number of patients that are admitted with active TB.

To have the TB test performed, free of charge, go to Employee Health during business hours:

Monday, Wednesday or Friday 7:30 a.m. to 4 p.m.
Tuesday 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

You will need to return to Employee Health two days later to have your test read.

No appointment is needed.

**TB tests on are NOT placed on Thursdays.*

Location: Employee Health is located where the blue and purple paths meet.
