

## **New Legislation Regarding Referrals for Incontinence Supplies**

**Providers:** Please read the below Q&A regarding Incontinence Certificate of Medical Necessity (CMN)

## What is changing?

All incontinence CMNs will now require two diagnosis codes:

- 1. The applicable diagnosis of the specific disease, injury, developmental delay, or developmental disability causing the incontinence.
- 2. The type of incontinence

## Who does it apply to?

Any Medicaid or Managed Care patient that requires incontinence garments or incontinence supplies.

## When does it go into effect?

Immediately. The new rule went into effect July of 2024.
