


**Social Story**Main Campus Outpatient Care (OCC)

We have to go inside to check in. We might have to sit in the waiting room after we check in.




A lab technician will call my name, and we will walk back to a special room down the hall.




I will sit calmly in the special chair with my hands on my lap and a quiet voice.






The lab technichian will push up my sleeve, and tie on a tight blue rubber band. I will feel a squeeze on my arm.





The lab technichian will put gloves on their hands.







The lab technician will touch my arm with their finger and then clean it with a wipe. It will feel cold and wet.






I will hold my arms, legs and body very still and take deep breaths.
