Compound Name: Sulfadiazine	Container-closure system(s): Amber Plastic Bottle
Strength: 100 mg/mL	Preservatives: Contained in Ora-Plus and Ora-Sweet

Ingredients: Sulfadiazine 500 mg oral Tablets Ora Plus Ora Sweet	

Instructions for preparation:**Calculations:**

1. Crush tablets in a mortar and triturate to a fine powder.
2. Wet powder with a minimal amount of Ora-Plus and levigate to form a viscous, but smooth and uniform paste.
3. Add small amounts of Ora-Plus, geometrically, mixing well after each addition until pourable volume.
4. Transfer to a graduate.
5. Rinse mortar with Ora-Plus, adding rinse to graduate.
6. QS to final volume with Ora-Sweet. Stir well.
