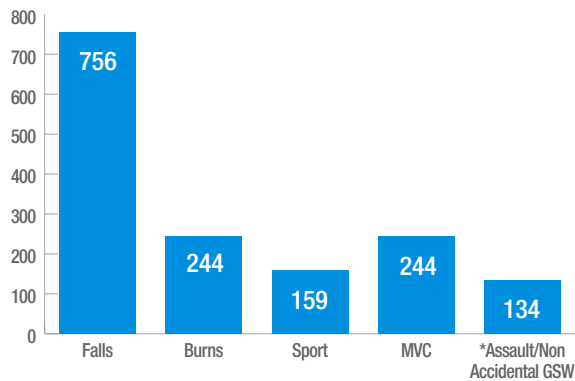

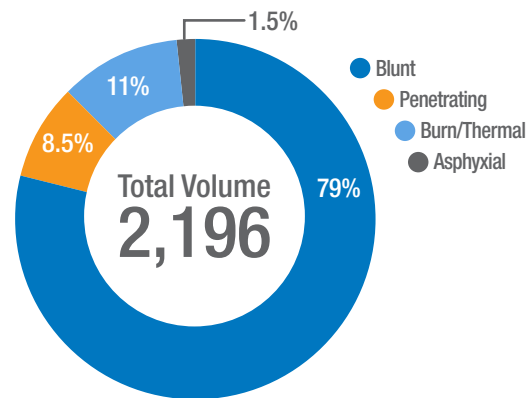

2017 Top 5 Leading Causes of Injury (Total Volume)

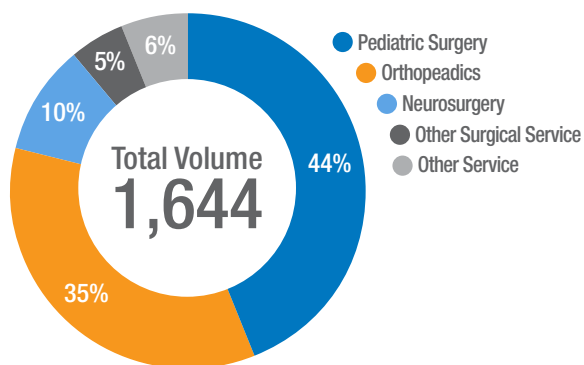


*Gunshot and/or Stab Wound

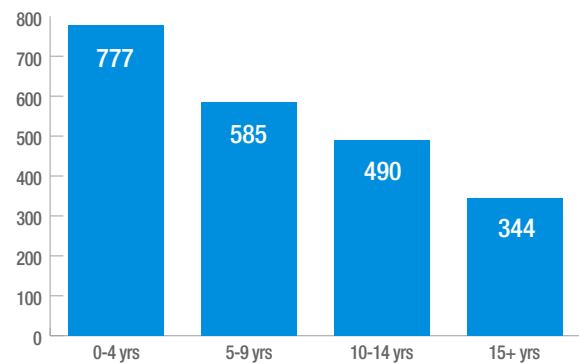
Trauma Type (Total Volume)
