<b>Disopyramide</b>	<b>Oral</b>	<b>Suspension</b>	<b>10mg/ml</b>

<b>Formula Qty: 120ml</b>	<b>Shelf Life: 28 days</b>
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### Equipment needed:

Glass mortar, glass pestle, glass graduate, amber GLASS prescription bottle

**Auxiliary Labels/Storage: Shake Well; Refrigerate (preferred) or Room Temperature; Protect from light**

Store in amber GLASS bottle

### Directions:

1. Empty capsules into glass mortar and triturate to a fine powder.
2. Wet powder with a minimal amount of vehicle and levigate to form a viscous, but smooth and uniform paste.
3. Continue adding vehicle, geometrically, mixing well after each addition.
4. Transfer to a glass conical graduate.
5. Rinse mortar with vehicle, adding rinse to graduate, until almost final volume.
6. QS with vehicle to final volume. Stir well.

**Note:** Reference listed tested 1mg/ml and 100mg/ml concentrations with equal stability. Prepare as directed using GLASS equipment only. Do not use extended release capsules.
