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Equipment needed:
Graduated cylinder, stirring rod, scale, hot plate or microwave to warm water

Auxiliary Labels/Storage: Shake Well; Refrigerate
No room temperature stability information.

Directions:

1. Warm distilled water.
2. Weigh zinc acetate powder and transfer to a graduate.
3. Dissolve powder in warmed distilled water.
4. QS to final volume with simple syrup. Stir well.

Note: Thick, clear, pale yellow suspension. Sour scent.
