Directions:

- 1. Warm distilled water.
- 2. Weigh zinc acetate powder and transfer to a graduate.
- 3. Dissolve powder in warmed distilled water.
- 4. QS to final volume with simple syrup. Stir well.

Note: Thick, clear, pale yellow suspension. Sour scent.
